### On-site update

The sheet piling works are drawing to a close and having reduced the rigging machines by one, we have also reduced the starting time of the piling until 9am from Monday to Friday. Backdriving works will shortly commence and the programme is anticipated to last 5 weeks. The basement excavation is underway and so far we have removed almost 3000 lorry loads. We have implemented a wheel washing system on site for all lorries leaving site, to lessen any debris from the vehicles being left on Westferry Road. Dust, noise and vibration levels are monitored on site and we continue to work closely with LBTH to mitigate any negative impacts

# **Open invitation to FORS event on 21st November**





FORS (Fleet Operation Recognition Scheme) is an industry recommended scheme whereby heavy transportation vehicles (HGVs and extra long vehicles) are fitted with additional viewing equipment which enables their drivers to have a greater awareness of other traffic on the roads, in particular cyclists and pedestrians.

The Metropolitan Police have an Exchanging Places scheme where cyclists and pedestrians are invited to sit in an HGV fitted with the FORS equipment to see for themselves how difficult it can be, to see a cyclist or pedestrian whilst in the lorry. The scheme focuses on road safety and provides those involved with a view from the driver's perspective. This can help people gain a better appreciation of the issues surrounding road safety.

The Westferry Printworks' team have organised an event on 21st of November between 4pm and 7pm where local neighbours, their children and cyclists are invited to come along to the Westferry site to sit inside a lorry and observe road safety from a lorry driver's perspective. The haulage company providing the lorry and drivers on the day will be Green Build Environmental who also provide us with the lorries on site. All of Green Build Environmental's drivers are FORS registered and will be on hand to answer any questions that local neighbours and cyclists may want to ask.

Local cyclist groups have been invited to attend and we will advertise the event on the Canary Wharf Facebook Page and our website in advance of the event. All you have to do if you want to attend is turn up on the day between 4pm and 7pm and you will have the opportunity to sit in the lorry cab with one of our drivers and ask them lots of questions concerning how the equipment works.
